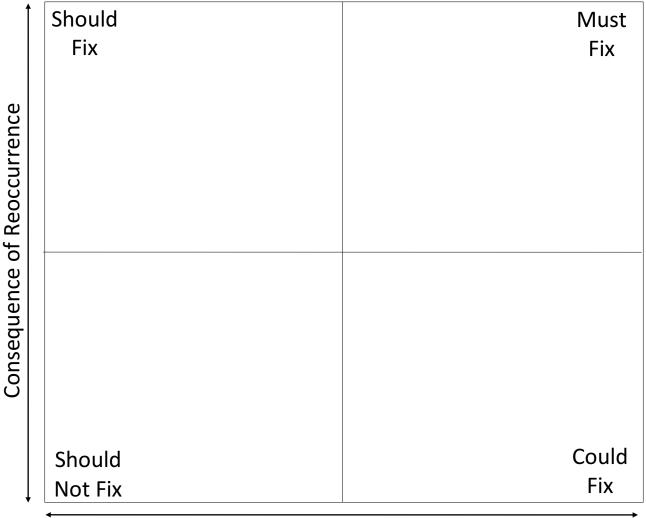
Follow these steps to use the matrix displayed below.

- 1. Spot and list potential issues that could be addressed.
- 2. Determine the likelihood of each issue reoccurring if not addressed.
- 3. Determine the consequence of each issue reoccurring.
- 4. Place each issue in the appropriate quadrant.
- 5. Discard any issue placed in either the Should Not Fix or Could Fix quadrants.
- 6. Determine the importance to the organization of any issue placed in the Should Fix quadrant.
- 7. Unless the Should Fix issue is deemed critically important by the organization, focus all energies on the items in the Must Fix quadrant.
